

Following you will find key dates about your Extended Essay, in a chronological order, to assist you plan and write your essay on time.

February 18th, 2015 (where: Theater, when: 13:30)

- This marks the start of the process that will end with a written Extended Essay
- Meeting with all year 11 students to
 - hand out timeline,
 - discuss deadlines,
 - present a sample hypothetical case,
 - answer initial questions

February 18th , 2015 - March 20th , 2015

- Students ought to read and research on their own, and consult as many teachers as possible during this period, in order to prepare the focus for their essay.

March 20th, 2015

All year 11 students must turn in to the IB Coordinator their Extended Essay Form **by Friday, March 20**th **(12:00)**. This is the final deadline for confirming your Extended Essay Subject / Topic and Supervisor. Extended Essay Forms will be available in the IB Coordinator's Office.

March 20th , 2015 - May 8th , 2015

- Discussion and research begin with Supervisor. This is a key stage of this timetable where the bulk of the research and experimentation is conducted.
- A step wise procedure and action plan must be developed and be available to the Supervisor for monitoring
- Before the end of this stage the Supervisor should have discussed the Extended Essay requirements specific to the subject area chosen.

May 8th, 2015 - May 20th, 2015

All year 11 IB students will be required to present a 1-2 minute progress talk on their Extended Essay in the theatre. These presentations will take place in the span of the dates shown above.

May 20th, 2015 - May 29th, 2015

Students should meet with their Supervisor to generate a summer work plan on their Extended Essay. Additional time to complete this procedure will be allocated during the IB Extended week, in June. All students must provide a copy of their plan to the IB Coordinator before summer vacation.

June 2015 – August, 2015

Extended Essay and IB Revision period begins; the exact dates will become available after the final examinations. Students are expected to work on the 1st draft of their Extended Essay, while research continues. Students are also expected to follow the summer work plan as specified by subject teachers.

Extended Essay Timeline (Academic Years: 2014-2016)



September, 2015

The 1st draft is due the first day of school, and it is submitted to the Supervisor for evaluation. Students are expected to meet with their Supervisors to discuss the 1^{st} draft.

October, 2015

The 2nd draft is due.

December, 2015

- School set deadline for the final copy.
- Make sure you have kept at least a backup copy of your Extended Essay file(s).
- Students are expected to turn their final draft of their Extended Essay in three copies:
 - o one in an electronic format (preferably in Word).
 - o a second copy (hard copy) as a backup one.
 - o a third copy (also hard copy) for your supervisor's file.
- All copies should have an appropriate cover page.
- Turn in all copies to the supervising teacher.
- No time extensions will be allowed.
