-John Lennon was born in Liverpool

on October 9, 1940

In 1956, he formed the Quarrymen, which changed into the Beatles
He gained worldwide fame as the founder, co-lead vocalist and rhythm
guitarist of the Beatles

John Lennon is famous for his music, but what really makes him stand out is his unwavering commitment to peace and social justice

He died in 1980 (aged 40) in New York City

**-James Paul McCartney** was born in Liverpool June 18, 1942 He began his career when he joined Lennon's group, the QuarryMen

McCartney played a key role in incorporating <u>experimental</u> aesthetics into the Beatles' <u>studio productions</u>

He gradually became the band's de facto leader

-George Harrison was the lead guitarist of the Beatles

Sometimes called "the quiet Beatle"

After the **Beatles disbanded**, Harrison produced his own music

-Sir Richard Starkey (born 7 July 1940) is known professionally as Ringo Starr

**He is** an English musician, songwriter and actor who achieved international fame as the drummer for the Beatles

As a teenager Starr became interested in the UK <u>skiffle</u> craze and cofounded his first band, the Eddie Clayton Skiffle Group

When the Beatles formed in 1960, Starr was a member of another group when he was asked to join the Beatles in August 1962
