


# DISCUSSION QUESTIONS




- What's going on here?

- **COMPLIMENTS:** After responding on Crabapple's artwork, do a compliment assignment where you anonymously write compliments about each other.
- **DRAW THEN COMPLIMENT:** Start with a line self-portrait, big on a piece of paper. I will send you your peer's compliments and you write them on the artwork.
- CREATE: FINALIZE THE COMPLIMENT PORTRAIT Decorate the piece accordingly by merging inspiration from the negative in Crabapple's work to the positive in the compliments activity.
- Use whatever materials or resources you have available. [Drawing, painting, collage, cut paper, sculpture, make a short movie, stop motion art, clay, playdough, assemblage art, recycled art, objects found in nature, fabric, digital art, photography, or any other way to create art you can come up with. Be creative!!
