The ISA Summer Program will run from June 23rd to July 18th and is designed for both English and Non-English speakers. The students are placed according to age level.

This Year's theme is "Endangered Animals"

A passionate team of teachers has designed an enriched program to help students enhance their English language skills while boosting their confidence in speaking, writing, listening, and reading. This year, the program will center around the theme of "Endangered Animals," exploring topics such as the world's most endangered species, how animals become endangered, the biggest threats to their survival, ways to protect endangered species, the impact of climate change on endangered species, and expressing the theme of endangered animals through art.

The weekly schedule includes Language Arts, Computers, Drama, Gross Motor Activities, Arts and Crafts. The athletics department is responsible for organizing group sports. The schedule also allows for a weekly beach trip to "Vrachos Beach" in Keratea.

On the program's first Friday, water games will take place on campus. During the Fridays of weeks 2 and 3, students will attend a field trip that includes sports activities. On the final day of the program, teachers will organize a Fun Day at school, featuring water games and a Talent Show.

The daily program begins at 9:00 AM. Students may be dropped off starting at 8:15 AM. Parents can pick up their children between 2:45 PM and 3:00 PM.
